Duties and responsibilities of Flying squads:

- To take precautionary measures continuously to see that no ragging takes place in the College Campus.
- To prevent any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- To Prevent indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- To Prevent asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- To monitor any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- To prevent exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- To prohibit any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.
- To prevent any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person.
- To prevent any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, posts, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- To see that Freshers' are provided with separate places at College Library, Hostel, Classroom Cluster etc to prevent free mixing of senior student with "Freshers".
- To continuously monitor and prevent the occurrence of Ragging at places like class rooms, library, canteen, hostels and other locations in the Campus.

- To monitor & prevent the occurrence of Ragging at the places outside the Campus such as:
 - Places where Students board the Buses / get down from the Bus outside the Campus.
 - Tea / Shops / Dhabas / Xerox Centers / Telephone booths outside the Campus but in the surroundings of the Campus.
 - Isolated locations in the Campus / outside the Campus but in the surroundings of the College where "Freshers" (Newly Admitted Students) may squat during their leisure hours.
- Incident of "Major or Minor Ragging" if occurs should be immediately reported to any of the members of the "Anti Ragging Committee".
- "The flying Squad" should inspect throughout the Campus and monitor the situation continuously as per the schedule given below:

Tuesday	:	Flying Squad No.2
Wednesday	:	Flying Squad No.3

Friday	:	Flying Squad No.5
Saturday	:	Flying Squad No.6
- "Flying Squad No.7" should visit the Campus on Sunday & other Holidays and keep vigil on the activities of the students in the Campus and Hostels.
- Flying Squad No. 8 is a special squad which should visit ladies hostel and monitor the situation in and around the "Ladies Hostel" continuously. This "all ladies" squad should visit the Ladies Hostel at least once in a day and talk to the inmates. Further any incident of "Ragging" of inmates of Ladies Hostel should be brought to the notice of the "Anti Ragging Committee" and initiate the measures to prevent the reoccurrence of such incidents.
