RESOLUTION

Recommendations from Er. Sunil. R. K

- The courses such as Aadalitha Kannada/ Vyavaharika Kannada, Universal Human Values, Tax Management and certified courses from IIT/ IISc/ SWAYAM and NPTELhave been appreciated.
- Tax Management course has to be incorporated in Engineering Elective. This course will ensure the students to access knowledge on various avenues for tax planning and tax management in construction sector and also it aids in understanding various exemptions and loopholes in Indian Tax Act.

- Spiritual Knowledge course has to be introduced in Open Elective as this course will release the mental stress on the students and ensures wisdom of spirituality among the students.
- Construction Safety, Construction materials stores and inventory,
 Construction planning techniques, Green Buildings and QA/QC should be introduced.
- The course Fluid Mechanics has to be more oriented towards field/ site scenario and the students should be taken to site visit for better understanding of the course.
- In Engineering Elective along with course Non Destructive Testing, Partial Destructive Testing can be introduced this will be beneficial to Civil Engineering students.
- The concept of labour loss should be introduced in Construction Management and Engineering Economics (Foundation Elective), as it plays an important role in construction sector.
- Structural Consultants and Project Management Consultants should be invited for software training and to deliver guest lectureson improved techniques in the respective fields.

Recommendations from Dr. K. Kumar

- Courses in electives similar to Core Courses have to be replaced with other courses.
- Labs should be given 3 credits instead of 2 credits.
- Construction joints and water proofing, Foundation Engineering, Placement Training, Computational Structural Mechanics, Advanced Design of Steel Structures and Basics of Structural Dynamics and Earthquake Resistant Design has been included.

Recommendations from Dr. P.S. Niranjan

- In 8th semester the L-T-P-S forProject Phase II & III and Evaluation and Viva Voce should be altered.
- Theory subjects have to be introduced in 8th semester.

- All Foundation Electives introduced in 3rdsemester should be shifted to 6th/ 7th semester.
- Subject matrix should be added as per UGC.
- Analysis and Design of Tall Structures has to be included.
- The electives can be grouped depending on stream viz., structural group, highway group, geotechnical group and environmental group.

- The marks in courses such asTechnical Report Writing & IRDP and Aadalitha Kannada/ Vyavaharika Kannada should be reduced from 100 marks to 50 marks.
- As Self Study is not mentioned anywhere L-T-P-S can be renamed as L-T-P.
- The credits in Basic Material Testing Laboratory should be changed from 3 credits to 4 credits.
- The numbering given for Foundation, Engineering and Open electives are confusing, find other way for labelling the electives.
- Hydrology and Irrigation Engineering and Water Resources Engineering should be made as core subject from Foundation Elective.
- Advanced design of temporary structure has to be included.
- The course Railways, Harbours & Tunnels should be split into two courses as Railways Engineering and Harbours & Tunnels. Railways Engineering should be made as core subject and Harbours & Tunnels as Foundation Elective,
- Courses should be reshuffled as students should know the basics of each and every course.
- The credits for project should be reduced.

Recommendations from Dr. B. C. Udayashankar

- Bridge Engineering/ Design of RC Bridges should be introduced.

- Design of Substructures/ Design Concepts of Substructures should be introduced.
- Basics courses related to all the streams should be introduced as core subject or in electives.

Recommendations from Mr. Sai Manohar

 The course Estimation and Valuation should be linked and explained as per Code of Practise.

- L-T-P-S has to be changed in 4th semester as it is mismatching.
- The courses such as Smart Materials and Sustainable Materials have to be introduced in Construction Technology and Management as these are the most highlighted courses in current scenario.

Recommendations from Mr.Karthik Patel.M. G

- The course Design of Precast & Composite Structures (Elective) can be introduced as Core subject.
- The courseMechanics of Deformable Bodies (Core subject)can be shifted to Elective.

Recommendations from Dr. P.S. Niranjan

- The marks for courses with 2 credits can be lowered from 100 marks to 50 marks.
- The L-T-P-S for project work in 4th semester should be removed and only credits should be kept.

- 1. The members studied in detail, the structure of the syllabus of 15IS32. It was found that the time frame fixed was not in accordance to the time frame required to teach appropriate depth level of the subject. Therefore the board approves the reorganization of the time frame.
- 2. The board studied the credit structure of the subject 15IS361. It was felt that the maturity level of the students may not be sufficient to grasp the subject at this level. At the same time, there was a necessity to place the state of the art "Python" language in some semester. Therefore, the board decides to carry forward this subject to higher semesters with one credit and the gap is filled with "Python Programming".
- 3. In the subject 15IS34, it was felt that the time frame required to teach the data structure "Queue" may not be sufficient to teach that maturity level of the students. Therefore, the time frame is reorganized.
- 4. The college has accepted to incorporate 36 credits for industry oriented subjects. The board felt that the industry needs training in various parts of the application. Therefore, it is felt that it is wise to introduce some more knowledge acquisition courses, which can be refined through industry oriented subjects, instead of directly industrial needy subjects.
- 5. The board ratifies the syllabi of third and fourth semesters of ISE department.

- > Devapp can be introduced as per the Industry demand.
- > Mobile application can be studied through online course.
- Javascrpit can be given more weight age in Web Technology course so that angular JS can be opted out.
- > 8-12 weeks of internship is recommended to students.
- 4. Dr. Gopalakrishna S G, Director, NES, Bengaluru, was suggested the following
- Eight(upto 12 weeks) weeks of internship to 3rd year students, either at the end of 6th semester or before 7th sem. Internship in company or at their workplace incase if student is placed during this period.
- Evaluation of the internship has to be done only in 8thsem.
- > Internship can have 3 credits and proper report should be maintained by students.
- 8th semester students should do online certification course and a seminar on the same can be done at the semester end.

- Academic curriculum should be a combination of online courses, self-study courses and class room teaching.
- Angular JS can be replaced by Digital Image Processing course.

All the committee members were happy that the students will be understanding the concepts as they have practice in the laboratory.

The committee was satisfied and happy with another Mechanical Engineering Course, Computer Aided Engineering. The credit for this integrated course is 4 which has 2 hour theory classes and 4 hour practice classes. The committee members felt that the students will be having exposure to the drafting software and they may use it in their professional life.

Finally, the BOS members have given their approval for the syllabus of Mechanical Engineering Foundation and Computer Aided Engineering Drawing and the syllabus of these two integrated courses were finalized. Also, they suggested to start the preparation of scheme and syllabus for the higher semester and advised to introduce new teaching and learning methods such as PBL, Online Courses etc. The meeting ended with vote of thanks by the Chairman

1. The AICTE Model Curriculum was discussed and accordingly the syllabus and scheme of Mechanical Engineering Foundation (IC) was modified by reducing

Prof. Poornima U K, Associate Professor, Department of MBA, Member, Board of Studies, welcomed the BOS members and gave a quick insight of the need for BOS meeting in the current year. Prof Rajeshwari G V, presented a briefed the minutes of previous year BOS meeting.

- ✤ <u>Agenda Point #1</u>: Dr. Geethanjali G, HOD and Chairman of the BOS, presented the proposed Scheme of syllabus for the new coming batch of 2021.
- + After the presentation the following suggestions were given by the members

Dr. S G Gopal Krishna, Director, NGI

- Dr. S G Gopal Krishna suggested that credits have to be given for the Skill Development Course, Campus to Corporate to bring in seriousness among students.
- It was suggested that in 4th semester, 6 subjects and a project will be very hectic for students. A maximum of 4 subjects should be a part of 4th semester. He mentioned that core subjects should be offered in 1st and 2nd semesters preferably and only electives should be offered in 3rd and 4th semester preferably. He felt that more flexibility should be given to students while selecting electives.
- Dr. S G Gopal Krishna also suggested that the faculty members should conduct online weekly monitoring of students going for internship in industry.

 MOOC courses may be introduced as an alternative to assignment and it was finalised by the BOS that it shall be included as one of the options for the internal assessment of the students.

Dr. Y. M. Satheesha, VTU Nominee

- Dr. Y. M. Satheesha suggested that as per VTU regulations, the internal and external assessment should be of 40:60 ratio, to which Prof Sriram said that internal assessment and MOOC courses will be conducted for 100 marks and reduced to 40 marks. For the Continuous and complete assessment of the students, modular based internal assessment was proposed. Dr. Y. M. Satheesha commented that the above said method is a very good idea.
- Dr. Geethanjali G requested the board members to agree to set two sets of CIE Question Papers instead of three to which all BOS members accepted the proposal of CIE Question Papers. And change Seminar 3 into a subject, credits of Organizational study shall be adjusted to match with the course International Business Management credits.
- Dr. Y. M. Satheesha suggested that there need to be rubrics for assessing the assignment and also Buddy system may be incorporated in assignments
- He also suggested that more credits should be given in 3rd semester so that there will be less load in 4th semester. He felt that two more credits may be added to Project work in the IV semester.
- He also mentioned that electives can be reduced to four, and only relevant syllabus must be added.
- Dr. Y. M. Satheesha suggested that MOUs with companies should be drafted such that industry integrated subjects should be given to students. Tests are to be conducted by the company and the same be reflected in the marks card.

- Dr. Mahesh suggested that business analytics as a specialisation should not be given, instead business analytics as a single paper /certification should be considered. He added that full -fledged 'Business Analytics as a specialisation' is not required for MBA students, to get into the industry.
- Dr. Mahesh suggested that soft skill training should be more rigorous.

 Dr.Biraj Ameet Anil, Assistant Professor, Department of MBA summarized the discussions in the meeting and proposed the vote of thanks. He also requested the members for their continual support.

Proceedings of the meeting:

Mrs. Poornima U K, Associate Professor, Department of MBA and Chairperson, Board of Studies, welcomed the members and gave a quick insight of the Curriculum designed for the Academic year 2019- 2021 and 2020-2022. The discussion happened after the presentation are given as follows:

- ★ <u>Agenda Point #1 and 2</u>: The new pattern of the Syllabus 2020-2022 was presented by Mrs. Poornima U K, Chairperson, BOS.
- Agenda Point #2: Presentation of III & IV Semester syllabus for 2019-21 Batch of MBA by Mrs. Poornima U K, Chairperson, BOS.
- Introduction of New Elective (Logistics and Supply Chain Management) for III & IV Semesters.
- After the presentation the syllabus of 2019-2021, the syllabus was finalised with minor changes. Those changes were related to the content of the subjects and respective subject matter experts noted them. It was finalised that not to offer Strategic Financial Management paper in finance specialisation and replace it with Goods and Services Tax (GST). This suggestion was given by Dr. P V Raveendra, VTU nominee.
- 2. After the presentation the syllabus of 2020-2022, the syllabus was finalised with following suggestions:

Suggestions by Dr. P.V. Raveendra:

a. Continuing with the existing scheme of valuation in which 50% weightage is given to Cie and 50% for SEE. Within CIE, the pattern to be adopted is 60:40 (Test: AAT)

b. The proposed syllabus consists of 3 seminars. He proposed 2 seminar and one course on soft skills for employability. But, in the proposed syllabus it has been incorporated as zero credit course in all the semesters.

c. Credits offered in total for Internship and Project Work were 16 Credits. He suggested to reduce the credit and introduce a new core paper. It was discussed and finalised to go with the proposed 16 credits for the same.

d. No Marks to be given for attendance was suggested by him and accepted by the Board.

e. Two test to be given for students for CIE. Makeup CIE can be offered in case of Medical Emergency, any other Genuine reasons and recommended by the counsellors.

Suggestions by Dr. M.R. Bharadwaj:

a. Internship and Project work need to be taken seriously by students. It was suggested that there should be a framework external assessment by the guide in organisation and the same should be reflected in assessment rubrics.

b. It was also suggested that once in a fortnight or a month, the concerned guide shall visit the organisation to review the progress. It was finalised by the BOS that visit shall be possible by the faculties for the company located in and around Bengaluru.

In case of projects undertaken by students other than Bengaluru, project review can be done by the Guide virtually.

c. It was also suggested that linkage has to be established between Internship and Project work. It was accepted by the BOS and deliberation took place in connection with implementation of it. BOS finalised to go ahead with the linkage provided they get permission from the company well in advance.

Suggestions by Dr. Harish Babu S:

a. He appreciated for offering Logistics and Supply Chain Management as specialization for the batches 2019-21 and 2020-22.

b. He suggested to offer Business Analytics as a specialisation for the batch 2020-2020. It was accepted by the BOS and subject matter experts needs to be identified to frame the syllabus.

c. It was suggested to include discussions and debates on regular basis for the students on current affairs and it should be included in the time table. The same was accepted by BOS.

d. MOOC courses may be introduced as an alternative to assignment and it was finalised by the BOS that it shall be included as one of the options for the internal assessment of the students.

e. It was suggested that in every area of specialization one certification course shall be introduced by the industry expert and the same can be included as zero credit course.

Suggestions by Dr. S G Gopalakrishna:

a. He stated that offering of two credit for Seminar and the consequent monitoring shall be a tedious task. It was suggested that students shall be put in smaller groups monitored by the counsellor for assessment. The same was reiterated by Dr. Harish Babu and the same was accepted by BOS.

b. Discussion and Debate among students shall be on Current Affairs and the same to be monitored in activity classes. The same was accepted by BOS.

c. The MBA program need to industry oriented which in turn gives practical exposure and real time experience for the students.

Suggestions from Members of BOS:

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a. It was suggested by the BOS members that entrepreneurship development activities has to be done by offering certification program/courses by prestigious organisations (Assocham, MSME, CII, Seva, Skill India) and creating an active ED cell.

b. The Department will consider and ensure to give the option of freelance or NGOs if required for the final semester projects.

c. Members of BOS are of opinion to introduce a greater number of certification courses relevant to the areas of specialization to bridge the skill gap and also to integrate the MOOC courses into the curriculum which are offered by reputed institutions which supports blended learning.

d. All the members were appreciated for their efforts made by the faculty members in drafting the new syllabus considering the current industry requirements and equipping them with the current technologies suitable for business and industry.

3. Introduction of New Elective (Logistics and Supply Chain Management) for III & IV Semesters.

All the members of the BOS agreed to introduce the new elective. Mrs. Poornima U K, Associate Professor, Department of MBA and Chairperson, Board of Studies summarized the discussions in the meeting and proposed the vote of thanks. She also requested the members for their continual support.



Agenda Point #1: Dr.Sandhya N, HOD and Chairman of the BOS, presented the

proposed Scheme of syllabus for the III & IV Semesters of MBA(Autonomous

Batch).
